This past school year it was not uncommon for us to have 70-80 children and youth on our campus on any given Wednesday night. On Sunday mornings we average around 35 children from infant to 5th grade in our nursery and Blast children's worship. Friends, we cannot miss the reality that the "harvest is plentiful." The Lord has given us great opportunity. But, without your willingness to serve we cannot reap a harvest. God has placed this opportunity before each of us.
